Through its programs and the many courses available, J N E offers students the opportunities to expand their horizons and visions, reinforce their ethical and moral values, develop their


communication skills and enhance their personal character and positive behavior to be competitive in the marketplace and to realize their role as leaders in their communities.

I wish the best of fortune, peace and prosperity to all those who contribute to the noble task of spreading education and its manifest qualities, aims and objectives.



y the beginning of the 20th century of the Christian era, the Muslim masses in the Malabar area in Kerala had lost the sense of borderlines demarcating the spheres of truth and falsehood. They had absorbed numerous innovations, accretions, exotic beliefs and practices which sapped their vitality to cope with the changing times. Most of them sunk into the lowest depths of ignorance, innovations decrepitude and destitutions. Nowhere in the Malabar area were any signs of health and vigour, but everywhere were stagnation and decay. Manners and morals had disappeared completely in a barbarous luxury of the few and an equally barbarous degradation of the multitude. Learning was



virtually dead and a few educational institutions which survived had been languishing in poverty and neglect. Like everything else, the religious faith was also decadent. The pure monotheism had become overlaid with a rank growth of supervision and mysticism. The mosques were deserted by the ignorant people who decked out in amulets, charms and

rosaries and were devotedly inclined to listen to squalid fakirs and dervishes. Life had apparently gone out of the Islamic way of life, leaving naught but a dry husk of soulless rituals and degrading superstitions behind. In short, the religion was looked down as something of a private concern having nothing to do with the affairs of the world.





The isolation of religion from practical life and its problems made the doctors of religion indifferent to the affairs of the contemporary world. And if they ever tried to interfere in these matters, they were exposed to ridicule because of their unfamiliarity with the modern thoughts and sciences. Unrelenting attacks were launched on Islam from all directionsphilosophical, historical, literary, scientific,

political and cultural, etc. While the Malabar Muslim community was passing through these critical stages, it tore itself into various groups and sects accusing each other of infidelity. The dangerous consequences of these critical situations were realized by some sincere and far-sighted scholars who were firm and staunch in their belief in the pure doctrines of Islam and held a high and venerable place in the society

on account of their piety and learning. They were very wise and possessed a vision that was broad and enlightened. They belonged to Moulana Abdul Kalam Azad's school of thought and had deeply impressed by the thoughts of Sheikh Mohammed Abdu of Egypt and Moulana Shibili Noumany of India. The guide and leader of this earnest group of scholars was Thayyil Mohammed Moulavi who was an outstanding theologian and spiritual mentor of this time.

The formation of Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen

ome venerable scholars, who dedicated their life to true faith and knowledge, after holding discussions and correspondence with the other Muslim divines of their time decided to establish an ideological, cultural and educational reformatory association. The main objective of this association was to bring about harmony and cooperation among the different groups within the Muslim society by purifying their faith from all kinds of superstitions and innovator conjectures and thereby make the ideological,

moral and educational reforms and progress of the Muslims. The association was named Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen and was registered under the society act XXI of 1860 with registration No.2/57. Its first session was held at Calicut city in 1950 under the presidency of Thayyil Mohammed Moulavi. In this session, the appeal was made for resolving the differences among the Muslim society for creating an atmosphere of unity and cooperation and for bringing about suitable charges and improvements in the outdated syllabi of the Arabic Madrasas.



The establishment of Jamia Nadwiyya

eeply moved by the educational, cultural and economical backwardness of the Muslim community after the Malabar revolt of 1921, the founders of Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen felt that unless some practical steps were taken to translate their ideas and objectives into action, it will not be possible to arrest the rapid decline of their community and set back on its feet. It was necessary to forge new weapons of culture,

education and progress. Their prolonged ties with the modern universities, colleges and schools inspired them with a new vision of a harmonious pattern of culture combining the best elements in the Islamic culture with the arts and sciences of the west. The first step, accordingly, was taken in 1964 with the establishment of Jamia Nadwiyya which earned soon in Kerala and other states as a modern seat of Muslim theological learning and Arabic

studies; Jamia Nadwiyya was established at Edavanna in Malappuram district which is an important centre of Muslims for many years.

Jamia Nadwiyya was established on 24/08/64 on the basis of a resolution adopted by the state council of Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen on 15/01/1964. It concerns itself with the Arabic syllabus which pays special attention to the Quranic Sciences, Traditions of the prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) and Arabic language and literature. On the other hand, it gives education in modern sciences.










- In all its curriculum and scholarly activities, the institute is strictly concerned with everything that can strengthen the spiritual life of students and revive the national sense among them.

The campus has a sprawling, picturesque and serene setting spread over 32 acres with lovely greenery and small hillocks presenting a typical rock garden studded with green flora and lively fauna. This idyllic campus with hillocks full of coconut trees, breaths out an inspiring, absorbing fragrance of academic spirit. Jamia Nadwiyya has constructed 9 academic buildings at the then estimated cost of 30 million Rupees. All these buildings house the different departments and academic activities of the institution.

he emblem of JNE is a pictorial representation of its holistic vision. It corresponds with the educational mission of Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen (KNM), the founder organization of JNE. The lighthouse at the apex is a symbol of divine guidance that suggests the organizational commitment to "empowerment through education" and its optimism about the ultimate victory over all forces of darkness. The open book symbolizes the Quran that advocates knowledge acquisition. It serves as the foundation of all institutional activities of JNE. The name Jamia Nadwiyya Edavanna is etched in English Alphabet on the periphery of a circle which represents the globe we live in. The Arabic calligraphy shows the linguistic and cultural orientation of the institution and the dissemination of Islamic values in a profound manner. This also manifests the close Indo-Saracen ties that prevailed in India for centuries. The open Holy Book contains the Quranic verse "I desire naught save reform so far as I am able". It implies that the extension of service to society is more important than any change brought out in the individual. JNE looks forward to a paradigm shift in the attitude towards society.

The Governance of Jamia Nadwiyya:

he overall governance of Jamia Nadwiyya lies in the Board of Trustees. The executive Council of Kerala Nadwathul Mujahideen nominates and elects members of the Board of Trustees. And the Board of Trustees appoints the Chairman, the Managing Trustee, the Director, the faculty heads and other employees. Their role in governance encompasses many duties and responsibilities. The board is responsible for strategic planning and oversight of the Managing Trustee who is responsible for carrying out the plans of the board of trustees.

Under the leadership of the board chair, the members of the Board of trustees

offer advice and counsel to the Managing Trustee. As the final authority for Jamia Nadwiyya, the Board of trustees makes all legal decisions, although they delegate some specific powers and duties to others. The board of trustees is responsible for developing and approving Jamia Nadwiyya's vision, mission, strategic goals and objectives, and establishing policies related to programs and services. One of the main duties of the Board of trustees is to approve the annual budget and to set major programs.

Jamia Nadwiyya Sharia College

amia campus has a sprawling, picturesque and serene setting. It was established in 1964 and it is an important educational hub for scholars in Arabic higher education. It aims to impart knowledge of Islamic theology and inculcate a high degree of Islamic values among the students. The Mission of Shariah College is to facilitate graduate and postgraduate studies in Arabic language and literature, Islamic theological studies and related disciplines.


To realise the vision of providing religious as well as secular education, Jamia Nadwiyya Shariah College offers BA (Afzalul-Ulama), BA (English) and BA (Fazeela) degrees. Pre-Fazeela and Afzal-ul-Ulama (Preliminary) are the other courses offered in the College. MA Arabic is also offered there. The Fazeela Course offered in the Institution is recognized by Hamdard University, Aligarh Muslim University and Madeena Islamic University. Arabic is the medium of instruction in all the courses. In order to ensure the standard of teaching and learning, it strives to provide residential accommodation, free boarding and excellent infrastructural facilities. Premium faculty, good library, computer centre, etc are the other features of this college. The Alumni of the College are known as Swalahi. They serve in various capacities throughout the length and breadth of India as well as in the middle-eastern countries.

Pre-Fazeela:

This course, Including the syllabus of plus one and plus two under the State Council for Open and Lifelong Education Scheme of Kerala (SCOLE Kerala) is designed with a view of imparting to the students advanced knowledge in the subjects of Humanities and Commerce. As different from the traditional higher

secondary course, this syllabus lays greater emphasis on the teaching of Muslim theological Subjects and the essential classical, medieval and modern contents of Arabic Language and Literature. It also pays great attention to the practical training in the functional use practically oriented course, in a of Arabic as a modern living language.

The practical aspects of the Arabic applied grammar and morphology are given due importance in the syllabi. Thus the program has been so designed as to serve not only as a scholastic and literary course, but also as a modern and comprehensive way.



Jamia Nadwiyya Post Graduate Programme in Hadith Literature:

Jamia Nadwiyya Post Graduation College in Hadith Literature was established in 1995. This postgraduate programme under Choice Based Credit semester system is designed to impart to the students advanced knowledge in the Hadith literature. The Course gives much emphasis to the detailed study of the history and development of the Hadith, important compilers and narrators of the Hadith, their authentic works and their influence on the development of Arabic literature, etc. Due importance is given in the syllabit to the contribution of Indian scholars to the Hadith literature. Adequate importance is also given to the study of the scholars of Hadith in the modern period.

Jamia Nadwiyya Training College



Jamia Nadwiyya Training College was established in 1995 with the concurrence of the Government of Kerala and is affiliated with the University of Calicut. Southern Regional Committee of NCTE has granted recognition to run B. Ed. course in the College. At the time of its establishment, there was no other government aided or unaided training colleges in Malappuram District. The College has an affluent library and seven laboratories for Educational Psychology, Social Studies, Science and Work Experience. Physical education and Art education rooms are also provided. A spacious playground with facilities for playing various sports and games is also made use of by the students. There are 200 students and faculty for teaching five optional subjects: English, Arabic, social studies, natural science and physical science.



Jamia Nadwiyya Arts and Science College

Jamia Nadwiyya Arts and Science College was established in 2003 in the self-financing sector to impart quality education and to mould graduates well-versed in modern science and professionally competent, socially responsible and morally sound citizens. The undergraduate courses offered in the College are: 1) BA (English). 2) B.Com, 3) B.Sc Physics and 4) BCA 5) BBA. The PG Courses offered are: M com and M.Sc (Physics). The College is affiliated with the University of Calicut. The performance of the students in university examinations is excellent. New initiatives have been taken up to build a centre of academic excellence.



Jamia Nadwiyya Women's Arabic College

Jamia Nadwiyya has been promoting higher education for girls. Accordingly, an Arabic College - exclusively for women - was established in 2013 as a recognized college affiliated with the University of Calicut.

This is a self-financing college offering BA Afzal-ul-ulama Preliminary and BA Afzal-ul-ulama Degree. A large number of girls enter the College for education and exit cheerfully to serve the community.

Jamia Nadwiyya Higher Secondary School (UNAIDED)

Edavanna Jamia Higher secondary School (EJHSS) was established in 2009. Humanities, science and commerce batches are offered in this school. The subject combination of Humanities includes Arabic and hence they can go for higher studies in Arabic also.

Jamia Nadwiyya Da'wa College

The Da'wa College was established in 2014 with the motto of moulding graduates with in-depth knowledge in Islam as well as in moral and ethical sciences and the capability of preaching Islamic ideology.

The courses offered in the College are: 1) Diploma in Islamic Preaching and Research 2) PG Diploma in Islamic Preaching and Research are the courses run in the Institution. Hectic Work is undertaken by students to prepare for the course. Students are provided stipends/scholarships to meet the opportunity costs of the course period. Very eminent scholars provide intellectual nourishment to them by way of lectures, discussions and debates. The alumni of Da'wa College are expected to be good preachers and ambassadors of Islam





Jamia Nadwiyya Residential Higher Secondary Schools for Girls (Aided)

The School was established under the Area Intensive Programme of the Government of India. and now, it is functioning in the general stream of higher secondary education. This is the only aided institution on the Campus. Humanities and science batches with 260 girls on rolls of the School are a great boon to the minority Muslim community. Good ambience and ample facility for learning and instruction are provided. Students are preparing well for competitive examinations along with the study for higher secondary examinations.



Jamia Nadwiyya Institute of Thahfeedhul Quran:

Established in 1995, by Jamia Nadwiyya Trust Board, the Institute works for protecting and promoting Quran studies by way of memorizing and reading with proper Tajweed. Boys above five years are admitted to the course and many of them succeed in memorizing the whole of the Quran within two years. 50 students are admitted to the Institute every year.

Jamia Nadwiyya Teacher Training Institute

This is a self-financing institution established in 2004, with recognition from NCTE and the Government of Kerala. The institution is intended to give training for teachers of primary schools. DEd Course is offered for 100 students in the Institution. The Institution has succeeded to a great extent in providing quality elementary education. By developing young men and women into enterprising professionally competent teachers, the Institution has rendered yeoman service to the nation. Library with internet connectivity, conference room and auditorium, well-equipped science lab and sufficient classrooms are provided as per the norms of NCTE.



Jamia Nadwiyya Residential High School (English medium)

Classes with Kerala State approved syllabus in English medium are offered in the School. It provides sufficient facilities to staff and students. LKG, UKG, lower primary and upper primary classes are conducted in the School. The School envisages becoming a role model, upholding moral and cultural values, and providing ample resources, guidance and patronage to the budding children to become God-fearing, patriotic and studious students so that optimum development of their personality can be attained.

Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Regular Study Centre

IGNOU has been established in 1985 by Govt of India for expanding opportunities for quality higher education and making it accessible to all. The Regular Study Centre was established in 2009. The Centre is offering a wide range of academic programs. The list of programs includes: (i) BA (English, History, Hindi, economics, sociology, Public Administration, Philosophy, etc. (ii) B.Com (iii) Diploma in Early Childcare and Education (iv) Certificate in Guidance (v) Certificate in Teaching English and (vi) Bachelors Preparatory Programme (BPP). IGNOU enrols students in two admission cycles - January and July.





Jamia Nadwiyya Central Library

Jamia Nadwiyya Central Library was established In 1964. The Central Library is the largest and the most expensive of all the educational resources in Jamia. It has books costing more than fifty lakh rupees and facilities for reading and reference in Arabic, English, Malayalam and Urdu. The objective of the library is the intellectual development of the staff and students of Jamia, by providing the necessary support for the teaching-learning process. The Library is really a learning support centre, a centre for self-study with electronic connectivity and other learning resources. Students' personality is positively influenced, communication skill is greatly enhanced and career guidance is greatly facilitated using the Library.

Almanar Pre-school

Almanar Pre-school is established to deliver quality education in elementary Islamic subjects. Almanar Pre - School was established with the main vision to mould and transform lives according to Islamic values enhanced through child friendly academic programs. At Almanar Pre-school, we offer comprehensive educational experiences to children that instill good moral and ethical values combined with academic excellence. 
إدارة الجامعة الندوية
